



Gianpaolo Dalla Vedova was born in Belluno, Italy, in 1970. He entered the Italian Navy Academy in Livorno in 1989 (Corso Arditì 1989-1993). He received the degree in Naval Architecture and Marine engineering from the University of Trieste, Italy, in 1996. From 1996 to 2002 he covered several roles as Engineer and Chief Engineer Officer (up to LT Commander rank) on board of Navy vessels in La Spezia, Taranto and Augusta, Italy; during this period he was also involved in major naval vessel refitting as project manager.

In 2002, he joined the Lloyd's Register EMEA: since October 2002, he has been involved on marine operation, with different roles, covering new building and material equipment and component survey business up to the role of Operation Manager for Italy, Malta and Adriatic Countries.
