



#### Short Bio Nadine Haase

Nadine Haase is the European gas regulation manager of PRISMA European Capacity Platform GmbH. In her current role she is very much involved in regulatory aspects of the operational and strategical development of PRISMA which is one of the most important platform operators for capacity trading in Europe. Before joining PRISMA, Nadine fulfilled different roles for N.V. Nederlandse Gasunie, mainly as a Public Affairs Manager for Germany and gained hands-on experience especially on how energy regulation and gas markets developed in Northwest Europe.

Nadine Haase has a Master's degree in political science from the Free University of Berlin where she specialized in international energy policy and international relations. She participated in the Trainee Program of the European Commission, working for the Conventional Energies Unit at the Directorate-General Energy and Transport, before she worked as associate research fellow at the Center for Clean Technology and Environmental Policy at University of Twente. In 2006, she was visiting fellow at the Gas Program of the Oxford Institute for Energy Studies. Nadine has been granted several scholarships, including from the Netherlands Organization for Scientific Research and has published several papers and articles on oil and gas markets. In 2009 she obtained her PhD degree by publishing her thesis on "European Gas Market Liberalization: Competition versus Security of Supply?" with the energy business school Energy Delta.
