Born Sept. 20 1955, Dominique MENU studied at ICN (Nancy Business School) in France then received two Masters Degrees (Sciences-Po Paris and Yale). He joined the banking sector as a Specialist in Project Finance and Asset-Based Financing where he worked for 10 years (1980's) on major industrial projects as well as on shipping and aircraft financing deals around the world.

During the 1990's, he was mainly posted in Transition Economies:

- Representative in the Soviet Union/Russia and CIS (1991/4) for BNP
- General Manager of BNP Dresdner (Croatia) (1997/mid2001) and
- Representative in Belgrade (mid 2001/4) for BNP Paribas,

He also spent an interim two year assignment (1995-1996) as Deputy Head of Risks for Europe & Middle East at the Paris headquarters of BNP.

Dominique Menu arrived in January 2005 in Kiev to establish the Representative office of BNP Paribas in Ukraine and was instrumental in BNP Paribas buying in April 2006 a 51% interest in UkrSibBank, Ukraine's 5th largest bank. He is now Member of the Supervisory Board of UkrSibBank. Dominique Menu has been a speaker at many conferences organized by the Financial Times, EuroMoney, IATA and others. Since 2012, Dominique Menu is also Country Head for Kazakhstan.
